

# Fred G. Kelly 2023 Hockey Tournament Rules

#### **General:**

- 1. All Hockey Canada and SSNS rules apply during the tournament.
- 2. Flooding will occur every two periods.
- 3. Gold Medal game will warm up on clean ice and then have a flood after the 2<sup>nd</sup> period.
- 4. Game PoG awards will be chosen by the coaching staff of their respective team.

## **Gameplay:**

- 1. All games will consist of three 15-minute stop-time periods with a 5-minute warm up prior to the game. In the event a team is ahead by 5 or more goals and the game is in the 3<sup>rd</sup> period the clock will run straight time and will not revert to stop time even if the lead becomes less than 5 goals.
- 2. Each team will be granted one 1-minute timeout per game.
- 3. In the event of a tie at the end of 45-minutes, the following process will occur:
  - a. 5-minute stop time, 3-on-3 sudden death overtime period
  - b. If still tied, a 3-player shootout will occur:
    - i. Home team will choose to shoot first or defer to visitor, coaches will submit a list of 3 shooters;
    - ii. If not decided after 3 rounds, the subsequent round(s) will become sudden death; and
    - iii. All players must shoot (except goaltenders) before a player can be selected to shoot again.
- 4. Points will be awarded in the following format in the Round Robin:
  - 3 Points Win
  - 2 Points OT/SO Win
  - 1 Point OT/SO Loss

#### Tie Breakers:

- 1. Two teams tied: head-to-head result in the game between the two teams.
- 2. Three teams tied:
  - a. head-to-head results;
  - b. If still tied, the ranking will be from the highest to lowest GF/GA ratio.
  - c. If still tied, the most GF.
  - d. Then a coin flip.

## **Discipline**

- Misconduct: any player, coach or team official who receives a game misconduct will be suspended for the remainder of that game plus the next game of the tournament. A second offence by the same person(s) will result in suspension from the remainder of the tournament.
- 2. Gross Misconduct, Match Penalty or a Fighting Penalty results in that person being automatically suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
- 3. Any coach or team official who in the eye of the tournament committee displays poor sportsmanship or sets a bad example will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament. This will be determined by the tournament organizers with no appeal.

### **Additional**

- 1. Coaches or Team Officials are responsible for:
  - a. Players and parents conducting themselves in appropriate manners and in the best interest of the game.
  - b. Having the team in the arena at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled game times.
  - c. Vacating the dressing room 20 minutes following the conclusion of their game, and leaving it in a clean, respectful state.
- 2. Referee's decisions are final, and no protests will be allowed.
- 3. All other decisions by the tournament committee are final.
- 4. Medals will be presented to the winning team.
